<Action Report>

On March 5, 2025, a seminar organized by Elmira Abasbekova was held at the Center for Standardization and Metrology under the Ministry of Economy and Commerce of the Kyrgyz Republic on the topic:

"Enhancing Energy Literacy Among the Population and Organizations to Improve Energy Efficiency, Develop Energy Saving, and Address Environmental Issues in the Kyrgyz Republic Based on Japan's Experience."

During the event, seminar participants were introduced to Japan's advanced practices in energy conservation and environmental sustainability and explored effective mechanisms and strategies for improving energy efficiency at both the organizational and household levels. Special emphasis was placed on practical recommendations for implementing energy-efficient technologies and policies.

A key focus of the seminar was raising public awareness about the importance of energy conservation when using household appliances, as well as examining the ISO 50001:2018 international standard. Experts discussed its significance in improving energy efficiency in organizations, reducing energy costs, enhancing environmental sustainability, and increasing business competitiveness.

The seminar served as a valuable platform for knowledge exchange and experience sharing. Experts presented practical solutions for implementing sustainable energy initiatives in the Kyrgyz Republic, contributing to more efficient energy use and an improved environmental situation in the country.

The event was attended by representatives of relevant ministries and agencies, as well as representatives of small and medium–sized businesses interested in developing energy–efficient solutions.

A systematic approach and active cooperation between the government, businesses, and the public in the field of energy efficiency and conservation are key factors in reducing carbon emissions in Kyrgyzstan.
